- ✓ The academic year will be from fall of 2024 through summer of 2025. Full-time attendance can include fall, winter, spring, and summer semesters
- ✓ Full-time United States employees of ServNet Auctions and their children, stepchildren, and grandchildren must plan to enroll in a full-time (minimum 12 credit hours each semester) course of undergraduate study.
- ✓ Part-time United States employees of ServNet Auctions must plan to enroll in a part-time (minimum of 6 credit hours per semester) course of undergraduate study.
